Where to eat, stay, shop and explore in Hamburg, Germany.

Hamburg, Germany might not be at the top of your German travel list—yet. But rest assured, we've found many reasons why you'll want to add this German city by the water to your vacation plans.

Stay

① The Henri Hotel

Bugenhagenstraße 21, 20095 Hamburg, Germany

The quaint boutique **HENRI Hotel** is perfectly located on Bugenhagenstraße, right next to a shopping area, a few minutes away from the Rathaus, the Speicherstadt district and the train station.

Visit

① Elbphilharmonie Hamburg

Platz d. Deutschen Einheit 4, 20457 Hamburg, Germany

The Elbphilharmonie, popularly nicknamed Elphi, opened in 2017 and is a concert hall in the Hafencity quarter of Hamburg.

Visit

① Beatles-Platz and St. Pauli

Reeperbahn 174, 20359 Hamburg, Germany

Five life-sized silhouettes at Große Freiheit and Reeperbahn. The Beatles got their first taste of stardom here in the 1960s.

Visit

① Hamburg's Rathaus

Rathausmarkt 1, 20095 Hamburg, Germany

Hamburg's Rathaus or City Hall is the focal point of the main city centre and where the city's politicians convene and work.

Do

① Book a Boat Tour

Bei den St. Pauli-Landungsbrücken 8, 20359 Hamburg, Germany

The St. Pauli Piers (or St. Pauli-Landungsbrücken 8) is the largest landing site in the Port of Hamburg. Catch a boat tour from several companies to sail through the canals and the port of the city.

Visit

① The Portuguese Quarter

Portugiesenviertel Hamburg, Germany

The Portuguese Quarter, or Portugiesenviertel, has been a part of New Town since the 1970s, when an influx of Portuguese moved to Hamburg to work in the nearby port.

Do

① A Hop on Hop Off Bus Tour

A hop-on/hop-off bus tour is a great way to spend your first day in a city to get your bearings and make notes of what you want to see later on during your visit.

Go

① Go Across Hamburg's Bridges

Just by visiting the Speicherstadt district, or the warehouse city, means you'll see many of the city's most famous bridges.
